



# Michiana Steelheaders River Tournament

## STEELHEAD ONLY

The entry fee is \$10 per person, with an optional entry fee of \$5 per person for BIG FISH. A 90% payout of entry fees will be made at the tournament. Prize money will be determined upon the number of entries. Prize money will be awarded to the top five steelhead caught:

**1st 40%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%, 5th 5%**

If only 4 fish are caught percentages will be 45%, 30%, 15%, and 10% of payout.

If only 3 fish are caught percentages will be 50%, 35% and 15 % of payout.

If only 2 fish are caught percentages will be, 60% and 40% of payout.

If only 1 fish is caught 100% of payout.

If no fish are caught prize money will roll over to the next scheduled tournament.

## TOURNAMENT RULES

This tournament is governed by DNR rules.

The fishing times are from **6:00am to 1:00pm** Eastern time.

Fish hooked after 1:00pm **CANNOT** be entered in the tournament. Fish hooked prior to but landed after 1:00pm may be entered. No lines in the water before 6:00am. Weigh in will be at Crawfords Park in Mishawaka Indiana (across from Merrifield Pool) Roll call will be at 2:00PM. Anyone not present, with their fish, will be disqualified. The one and only exception will be if your boat breaks down. If this happens, you must contact **Dale Stark** (the tournament chairmen) immediately at **574-315-4689** before roll call ends. You or one of your crew must arrive before the weigh-in is complete. When weighing in your fish, it is your responsibility to choose your biggest fish to be weighed in. You cannot weigh more than one fish to determine which is the biggest. You may fish the St. Joe River only from the Twin Branch Dam to the railroad bridge in St. Joe Michigan. Entries are accepted on the honor system. You may NOT fish any tributary of the St. Joseph River. For example, employees or members of the Issac Walton League may not fish Juday Creek. When fishing from a boat, all people in the boat must be registered in the tournament. A formal dispute may be brought to the chairmen within 15 minutes of the closing of the scales. All disputes will be settled by The Tournament Committee
